

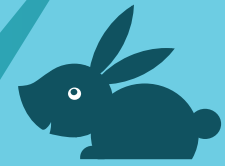


Give Rabbits

SPACE

6ft (2 metres)

10ft (3 metres)



Whether you have house rabbits or outdoor rabbits you should aim to give them a PERMANENT area of 10ft x 6ft, and aim for 3ft high (1m). This is the minimum we recommend for up to two rabbits to meet their welfare needs. Remember that rabbits should be kept in neutered pairs, but even one rabbit would need as much room as two to run, jump and binky.
