Wherever your rabbits live, protect them in hot weather.

- Shade them from the sun, provide cool pods to lie on and plenty of water. Remember the sun moves around during the day
- Keep bottoms clean to avoid fly strike
- Make sure wasps haven't built a nest in their accommodation
- Use mosquito nets to keep out biting insects. This and up to date vaccination will help protect against Myxomatosis
